The petitioner is aggrieved against notice (Annexure P-11) dated 28.7.2015, asking him to pay ₹43037/- within a period of seven days, otherwise, the said amount is stated to be recovered under the provisions of Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887.

At the threshold, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner may be allowed to reply to the notice before any decision is taken by the respondents for recovery as according to the petitioner the said amount has already been waived.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and examining the record, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner deserves one opportunity to explain to the respondents that the amount, is being demanded, has already been waived.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby disposed of with an opportunity to the petitioner, to reply to the respondents within a period of seven days from today and the said reply shall be considered by the respondents, after affording an opportunity to the petitioner, before taking decision about the recovery of the alleged amount.

Till then the recovery of the amount shall remain stayed.
