The prayer of learned counsel for the petitioners is for directing respondent No.3 to bring the petitioner in the select list 'C' at par with his juniors on the basis of standing order No. 1/92 dated 22.07.1992 (Annexure P-1).

For claiming the aforesaid benefit which allegedly has already been given by the department to a number of similarly situated candidates, the learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted legal notice dated 08.09.2014 (Annexure P-22) to the respondents followed by reminder dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure P-23).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states, that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied, if direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the legal notice.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and take a decision on the legal notice (Annexure P-22) by passing a speaking order expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
