Mr. P.S. Poonia, learned counsel for the respondents has filed a copy of order dated 15.04.2015, which is taken on record and marked as Mark-X and attached at the end of the paper book, to contend that the petitioner has been granted deemed date of promotion as Junior Engineer w.e.f. 26.07.2005 from the date his junior Sh. Jarnail Singh belonging to the general category was promoted as Junior Engineer and his pay has been ordered to be notionally fixed w.e.f.

26.07.2005 and the actual benefit of the pay fixation will be admissible from the date he actually joined as Junior Engineer.

Mr. R.S. Bains, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner may be given a opportunity to challenge any part of the order.

Since the main relief sought in the present writ petition has been granted.

In view of the order dated 15.04.2015, present writ petition is rendered infructuous with a liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order in case the petitioner aggrieved of any portion of it.

Writ petition is disposed of.
