Learned counsel submits that the petitioner seeks grant of ACP scale at the 23 year point, which fell due to him in the year 2003. Without doubt, there is a delay of 12 years in approaching the Court; however, he submits that the loss is a recurring one even affecting his pension on a monthly basis (as the petitioner has since retired, on 31.12.2014).

In view of the fact that the grant of the ACP scale, if found due to the petitioner by the authority, would in fact enhance the petitioners' remuneration on a monthly basis, and it is thus a recurring loss, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the petitioners' representation dated 19.08.2014 (Annexure P-2), which is still stated to be pending with the said respondent, in accordance with law, within a period of three months of the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to say, that if the said ACP scale is found admissible to the petitioner on merits, the arrears to be granted to the petitioner, would be suitably restricted by the respondents.
