Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to declare that the petitioner is entitled to use the red-light with flasher on the official vehicle of the petitioner in the capacity of Mayor, Municipal Corporation, Ambala.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana, to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as mentioned in representation dated 30.07.2015 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and communicate the decision that may be taken to the petitioner.
