Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the salary, allowance and all other benefits of the petitioner along with interest for delayed period.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents, to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as mentioned in representation dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law. If the petitioner is found to be entitled to the salary and allowance as prayed for, the same shall be released to him. Needful shall be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
