Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though now both the petitioner and respondent No.4 have retired yet while they were in service, the petitioner has filed repeated representations (Annexure P-6 (Colly.) one of which is dated 10.01.2014 to promote him as Deputy Registrar w.e.f. 10.07.2013 and to grant him consequential benefits arising therefrom but no decision thereon has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-Company states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if the directions are issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 10.01.2014 (Annexure P-6 (Colly.) within a reasonable time.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 10.01.2014 (Annexure P-6 (Colly.) expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
