The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is loanee of respondent No.2 bank, challenging the order dated 21.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Debt Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh, whereby the interim order passed in SA No. 347 of 2014, titled as Inderjot Singh versus Punjab and Sind Bank and others, qua status quo has been vacated.
