Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of lists of wards, having different population, issued by respondent No.2 (Annexure P/1) and Public Notice dated 16.11.2014 (Annexure P/3) issued by respondent no.3 in violation of Rule 6(b) of the Delimitation of Wards of Municipalities Rules, 1972.

The petitioners are relying upon lists of wards (Annexure P/1) which is wardwise calculation of voters for the year 2014 of Municipal Council Rama. As per provisions of Rule 6(b) of the Delimitation of Wards of Municipalities Rules, 1972, each Municipalities shall be divided

into wards in such manner that the population of each ward, as far as practicable, is the same throughout the Municipality, with a variation upto ten per cent.

The petitioners are only relying upon the voter list and there is no document to indicate the variation in the population of ward.

In view of this, instant writ petition is dismissed with liberty to file a fresh one on the basis of population.
