Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing of order dated 21st May, 2015 (Annexure P-5) whereby retiral benefits due towards the husband of the petitioner were not being released. In the reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1, it is stated that the entire retiral benefits due to the petitioner have been released. It is submitted as under:-

- iii. *“That as per the report of the Regional Deputy Director, Ferozepur, it has been informed that the entire retiral benefits have been released to the petitioner and the family pension is also being given to her regularly on monthly basis. Copy of the report from DDR, Ferozepur is attached herewith as **Annexure R-2**.*
- iv. *That the answering respondent sought information from the Nagar council Abohar and vide information dated 22.07.2015, and it has transpired that the entire retiral benefits amounting to Rs.21,66,555/- have already been disbursed on various dates and lastly on 12.09.2014. The letter/report dated 22.07.2015 is attached here with **Annexure R-3**.*
- v. *That therefore, there is no subsisting claim by the petitioner, which is pending and hence at this stage the petition deserves to be dismissed as infructuous”.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner sought time on 16th October, 2015 to verify whether the entire benefits due to the petitioner have indeed been released. Today none is present to represent the petitioner.

In view of the reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1, present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is afforded to the petitioner to revive this writ petition in case any further claim survives.

Disposed of accordingly.
