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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the balance 25% of the arrears of the salary for the period from 1.1.2006 to 31.08.2009 and three annual increments with ACP Pay Scale, to which he is entitled, has not been paid by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that under the provisions of Rule 51(1)(c) read with Rule 65(2) of the Haryana School Education Rules, 2003, a duty has been cast on respondent No.2 to ensure that the necessary payment be made.

For claiming the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has already submitted a legal notice dated 24.05.2015 (Annexure P-7) through his counsel, but no action has been taken thereon so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent

No.2 to consider the notice (Annexure P-7) and decide the same.

In view of the aforesaid, without going into the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.05.2015 (Annexure P-7) expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
