ARUN PALLI, J.(ORAL):-

 Contends that vide order being assailed in this petition i.e.dated 18.01.2014 (Annexure P3), respondent No.4 has revised the seniority list of Head Constables including the petitioner in purported compliance of the directions issued by respondent No.2, vide memo No.24558-24658/E 3, dated 22.09.1998, and in terms of the orders rendered by this Court in CWP No.21847 of 2011 and other connected matters. It is maintained that a revision in the seniority list has been carried out without any notice, intimation or any opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.

 Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to represent the respondents in the first place. And the respondents be directed, that in case any such representation is made, the same shall be decided within a stipulated period of time.

In the wake of the position as set out above, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, without expressing any opinion on merits, it is observed that in case, the petitioners prefer any such representation as regards the revision in the seniority list of Head Constables, vide order dated 18.01.2014 (Annexure P3), the same shall be decided in accordance with law, within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to assert, a comprehensive order shall be passed assigning reasons, in support of the decision arrived at.
