Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing of impugned order dated 30.01.2015 (Annexure P/3) passed by respondent no.4 – Registrar of Marriage-cum-Secretary, Municipal Council, Fatehabad whereby application moved by the petitioners for registration of marriage has been declined. Further prayer is made for directing the respondents to decide the representations dated 07.05.2015 (Annexures P/5 and P/6).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have already moved representations dated 07.05.2015 (Annexures P/5

and P/6) to respondents no. 2 and 3 – Sub Divisional Magistrate,

Fatehabad and Deputy Registrar-cum-Chief Registrar of Marriage, Fatehabad, respectively. Learned counsel further submits that since petitioner no.2 – Ramandeep Singh has attained the age of 21 years, so now he fulfils the conditions for registration of marriage.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondent no.3 – Deputy Registrar-cum-Chief Registrar of Marriage, Fatehabad, to look into the grievance of the petitioners specifically made in representation dated 07.05.2015 (Annexure P/6) and take appropriate action in accordance with law. The petitioners will be at liberty to move another representation to respondent no.3 specifying attaining the age of their majority.
