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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner has filed the instant petition praying for direction to the respondents to decide the issue of unsanctioned leave i.e. medical leave from 20.01.1997 to 27.03.1997 and earned/extraordinary leave from 01.04.1997 to 17.08.2000, medical leave from 09.03.2006 to 30.06.2006. He has also prayed that the respondents be directed to treat the join period from 09.04.2007 to 29.01.2013 as duty period for all practical purposes including full pay and promotions, as during this period, he was not allowed to join his duty by the respondents.

For claiming the aforesaid reliefs, the petitioner has already submitted a legal notice dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) through his counsel, but no action has been taken thereon.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on his legal notice.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take into consideration legal notice dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) and dispose of the same by passing a speaking order expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
