Prayer made in the present writ petition is for issuance of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant benefit of higher grade under the Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACP) on completion of 8/9/14 years of service as applicable to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 22.4.2015 (Annexure P/5) within a specified period wherein he had made his claim for the said benefit under the ACP scheme.

Without going into merits of the case and keeping in view the limited relief sought for, the present petition is disposed off without calling the respondents to file their reply.

Respondent no.2 is directed to take a decision on the representation dated 22.4.2015 (Annexure P/5) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Needless to say that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the benefit in question, the amount be paid within a period of two months thereafter and in case the relief is to be denied to the petitioner then reasoned order be passed by the said respondent.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
