The petitioners have filed this petition praying for directions to the respondent – Sugar Mill to regularise their services on the posts of Security Guard as six posts are lying vacant in the Mill.

It is stated that petitioners No.1 and 2 are working since the years 1991 and 2004, respectively. In 2009, four persons, senior to the petitioners were regularised and now the petitioners are next in line. Despite the availability of the vacancies and the instructions dated 16.2.2009 (Annexure P-8), the matter regarding regularisation of the petitioners has not been considered so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that for claiming the aforesaid relief, the petitioners have also submitted representation dated 21.1.2013 (Annexure P-9) to the respondents, but no action has been taken thereon. He has further stated that at this stage, the petitioners shall be satisfied, if the respondents are directed to take a decision on their representation in terms of the instructions Annexure P-8.

Accordingly, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and take a decision on the representation dated 21.1.2013 (Annexure P-8) expeditiously, in accordance with law. The petitioners, if so desire, may supplement the said representation within thirty days, which will also be taken into consideration by the said respondent.
