Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent nos. 2 to 5 to take final decision on letter dated 07.02.2014 (Annexure P/5) regarding inclusion of areas of Villages Langrian and Dayalpur Chhanna, in the area of Nagar Panchayat Amargarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the areas of Villages Dayalpur Chhanna and Langrian were proposed to be included in Nagar Panchayat, Amargarh as a result of which no elections of gram panchayats were held for these villages in July, 2013. Learned counsel further contends that the matter is lingering on in spite of formation of a

committee vide letter dated 07.02.2014 (Annexure P/5). Learned counsel further contends that the petitioners and others have made representations (Annexures P/6 and P/7), but no decision has been taken thereon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case and without giving notice to the respondents, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners specifically made in the representations (Annexures P/6 and P/7) and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Needful shall be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated to the residents of the villages and other authorities.
