In view of the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 2,
no relief can be granted to the petitioner on merits.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that
respondent No.3 may be directed to refund the fee deposited by him at the
time when he took the admission in the 3rd years.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3, while referring to para 6
of its reply, has submitted that a decision has already been taken to refund
the fee to the petitioner of the 3rd year provided he tenders 'No Dues
Certificate' to the College.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that
extra amount charged from him amounting to ₹75,000/-+₹17,500/- by
respondent No.3 in the years 2009 and 2010 be also refunded.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and keeping in

view the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is dismissed on merits. However, a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to refund the fee deposited by the petitioner in the 3rd year amounting to ₹1,85,500/- and shall also consider the case of the petitioner to the amount of ₹75,000/- + ₹17,500/- stated to have been charged extra by respondent No.3 in the year 2009-2010. While considering the claim of the petitioner in respect of the amount charged extra by respondent No.3, speaking order shall be passed by the College itself.
