Prayer made in the present writ petition is for a direction in the nature of mandamus to the respondents to disburse the arrears of pay, emoluments for the for the period during which the petitioner held the additional charge of the higher post of Junior Engineers.

It has been averred in the petition that the petitioners who are Work Munshis had been assigned higher duties of Junior Engineers and performed their duties as such. They were, thus, entitled for the financial benefits.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that various representations have been filed to the respondents and he will be satisfied if the respondents takes action on the said representations. Reference is made to the representation dated 07.08.2015 (Annexure P11) and reliance has been placed upon the judgment of this Court in CWP No.13002 of 2012 titled *Hardev Singh & another Vs. State of Punjab & others*, decided on 06.12.2012 (Annexure P9). It is submitted that the respondents filed LPA No.493 of 2013, which was also dismissed on 09.04.2014 and the Special Leave Petition filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court also met the same fate. The said facts find mention in the representation itself.

Accordingly, this Court is of the opinion that the present writ petition can be disposed of and the respondents need not be called upon to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the said representations, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the relief is to be denied, reasons should follow.
