Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that as per instructions received by him, the respondents are in the process of withdrawing the impugned orders dated 08.07.2013 (Annexure P-7) and 30.08.2013 (Annexure P-9) and same would be withdrawn within a period of 15 days from today. Learned counsel further submits that the respondents be granted liberty to proceed against the petitioner afresh, after following the principles of natural justice.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no objection, if the prayer made on behalf of the respondents is accepted.

That being so, on the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents and in view of the no objection of the counsel for the

petitioner, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly. However, the respondents are granted liberty to proceed against the petitioner afresh after following the principles of natural justice.
