Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is for direction to the respondents to grant 1st and 2nd ACP after completion of 10 and 20 years of service in the department w.e.f. 01.01.2006 and revised pensionary benefits, etc. and interest thereupon.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the ratio of law laid down in ***Prem Paul and others Vs. The Managing Director, Uttar Haryana Bijli***

Vitran Nigam and others (CWP No.14580 of 2006, decided on 07.05.2008).

In the circumstances, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to examine the case of the petitioner as to whether the same is covered by Prem Paul's case (supra). In case, the authorities reach to the conclusion that the case of the petitioner is covered, then the consequential relief be released to him forthwith.

The entire exercise be completed within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
