HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is running a petrol pump under the scheme of Kishan Sewa Kendra, at village Alikan, District Sirsa. The said petrol pump is situated on the main road and is running for 24 hours. For his personal security and safety, the petitioner applied vide application (Annexure P/2) for issuing a new arms licence. He contends that the application was verified by the local police and the necessary verification report was sent by the Station House Officer, P.S. Bara Gudha for further processing . The Senior Superintendent of Police, Sirsa vide his report dated 12.8.2013 submitted to the Deputy Commissioner, Sirsa recommending the application of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite repeated representations sent to the competent authority, no decision thereon has been taken so far. He states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is

issued to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the application dated 10.01.2013 (Annexure P/2).

In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the application of the petitioner with regard to issuance of a new arms licence expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
