Admittedly, resolution no.3 dated 23.1.2014 (Annexure P/1) is the subject matter of consideration before respondent no.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab at the instance of one Bhajan Singh and the said resolution has been stayed. The dispute is regarding the construction of under ground pipes/drain and the drainage of sullage water. The petitioners also seek a direction that sullage water should not be put in pond no.2 which is adjoining the agriculture land of the petitioners and other villagers since due to overflow of water in pond no.2, it is regularly damaging the agriculture land of the petitioners. Reliance has also been placed upon the report dated 23.6.2014 (Annexure P/4) and letter dated 26.6.2014 (Annexure P/5) whereby certain recommendations have been made to rectify the problem of drainage of sullage water.

In such circumstances, this Court does not feel it necessary to interfere at this stage and relegates the petitioners to seek their remedy for appropriate relief before respondent no.2 where the dispute is already pending. The petitioners are at liberty to file an appropriate application to join proceedings.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
