Instant writ petition has been filed with the averments that the petitioner-company has undertaken and completed various works. In spite of completion of work, entire payment has not been made. It is pleaded by the petitioner that he has already submitted a representation dated 20.07.2015 (Annexure P/3), but no decision has been taken thereupon so far.

In view of above, this Court deems it fit that the instant petition can be disposed of at this stage, without expressing any views on the merits of the case. Keeping in view the peculiar facts of this case, respondent No. 3 – Executive Engineer (P.H.), Punjab Mandi Board,

(Annexure P/3) after examining the issue in accordance with law, within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and the decision shall be communicated to the petitioner. If anything is found due to the petitioner, the authorities may disburse the same to the petitioner subject to their rights of refund, set-off, counter-claim, etc.
