It is stated that for the grant of desired relief, the petitioner has already sent a legal notice (Annexure P/2) prior in point of time i.e. 29.04.2015 to respondent no.2 – District Food & Supply Controller, Fatehabad, but no decision has been taken thereon so far.

Consequently, without commenting on the claim of the petitioner, instant writ petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent no.2 – District Food & Supply Controller, Fatehabad to take a conscious decision on the claim of the petitioner contained in legal notice dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure P/2) and pass a reasoned order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner.
