The petitioner seeks for quashing the letter issued on 30.04.2013 (Annexure P12) by the Haryana State Pharmacy Council, declining to register the petitioner under the State Council on the ground that the petitioner has obtained the qualification of Diploma in Pharmacy from Rajasthan. Subsequent to the filing of the petition, at the first executive meeting of the HSPC, dated 02.07.2014, the State council has passed a resolution “*that for candidates who have passed 10+2 from the State other than the Board of Secondary Education Haryana Bhiwani or CBSE, New Delhi their qualification must be got verified from the concerned board before registering them in the Haryana State Pharmacy Council. Also, if any candidate who have his/her pharmacy from*

institution other than institution situated in Haryana, his/her qualification should also be verified from the Institution/Board from where he/she has obtained such qualification.”

2. In the light of the resolution, the impugned order cannot be sustained, for, a mere qualification from any institution other than Haryana would still require to be verified by the State Pharmacy Council and an appropriate decision taken. The impugned order is quashed. The petitioner's request for registration may be considered afresh in the light of the proceedings of the Executive Committee on 02.07.2014. The petitioner may furnish to the State Council the qualification in 10+2 if it was from a Board other than the Board of Secondary Education Haryana, Bhiwani or CBSE. If the necessary particulars are furnished, the respondent will take a decision and communicate the same within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of relevant document and communication.

3. The writ petition is disposed of on the above directions.
