Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to register the marriage of the petitioners in view of Division Bench judgment of this Court in **Baljit Kaur Boparai vs. State of Punjab, 2008(3) PLR 326.**

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.S. Chandumajra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners

have already moved representations dated 20.08.2015 (Annexure P/5) to respondent no. 2 – Registrar of Marriages, Zira, District Ferozepur. Learned counsel further submits that since petitioner no.1 – Baldev Singh has attained the age of 21 years, so now he fulfils the conditions for registration of marriage.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 – Registrar of Marriages, Zira, District Ferozepur, to look into the grievance of the petitioners specifically made in representation dated 20.08.2015 (Annexure P/5) and take appropriate action in the light of **Baljit Kaur Boparai's case (supra)**.
