It is undisputed that against the impugned order, a revision petition under Section 115 of the Haryana Co-operative Societies Act, 1984, is maintainable before the Government. Once the petitioner is having an equally efficacious alternative remedy, he must avail that remedy first before approaching this Court, by invoking its writ jurisdiction.

In view of the above, petitioner is relegated to his alternative remedy of revision.
