All the three petitioners, who are students of B.V. Science and Animal Husbandry, a five year integrated course, in the College of Veterinary Science (respondent No.5 herein) affiliated to the Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana, have filed this petition seeking direction to the respondents to admit them in internship session of Xth semester of Five Year Degree Course, as they have qualified IXth semester regularly as per the course of practical and theoretical subjects.

It is the case of the petitioners that respondent No.5 College on the plea that the petitioners have not cleared the tracking course, which they are supposed to clear have withheld their admission to the Xth semester.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the tracking course was to be completed any time between the 2nd and 5th year and as the 5th year of the petitioners is going on, during this year, they can clear the said tracking course, therefore, the respondent No.5 College was not justified to withhold the admission of the petitioners in the Xth semester.

Undisputedly, the petitioners have not made any representation in this regard to the higher authorities, i.e. the Registrar of the respondent University. Therefore, we permit the petitioners to make such representation to the Registrar of the respondent University with regard to the aforesaid relief. If any such representation is made by the petitioners, the Registrar of the respondent University is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably within a period of two weeks from the date of making of such representation by the petitioners.

Disposed of accordingly.
