By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents to revise the pension of the petitioner upto the extent of 20% of revised basic pension on attaining the age of 80 years, in view of the notification dated 17.04.2009.

The learned State counsel refers to the communication dated 25.02.2015 from the Branch Manager, State Bank of India and states that the necessary relief has been granted to the petitioner and now the petitioner has been drawing salary at the enhanced rate.
