The petitioner has challenged the order dated 4.10.2012 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent No. 1, in the second revision, filed by respondents No. 4 and 5. The issue involved was, thus, as to whether the second revision is maintainable or not?

Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 and 5 has produced an order passed in **CWP No. 9646 of 2013, Surjeet Singh vs. Joint Registrar (planning), Cooperative Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh and ors dated 13.8.2015** relying upon an order passed by the Supreme Court in **Ishwar Singh vs. State of Rajasthan and ors, 2005(1) SCT 525**, holding that second revision is maintainable.

Accordingly, in **Surjeet Singh's case (supra)**, the matter was remitted back to the Government for consideration in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 69 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961.

After considering the factual circumstances, the present petition
is dismissed in view of the order passed in *Surjeet Singh's case (supra)*.
