The petitioner has been held to be a tenant by the Civil Court in a shop owned by Municipal Council, Moga. The premises is now required to be dismantled for construction of a slip road on the National Highway. Since the petitioner is to be up-rooted, he is said to have made a representation for allotment of an alternative shop by constructing the same on the rear side where some land is stated to be available.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, though we are satisfied that such a relief can be claimed within the frame-work of a policy and it is not expedient for this Court to issue direction for allotment of an alternative site but since the petitioner has made a representation to the respondent-authorities, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Moga to consider the above mentioned representation and decide the same, in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date a certified copy of this order is received.
