The petitioners in effect seek implementation of an order dated 16.03.2015 passed by the District Town Planner Enforcement, Panipat. The order holds that the construction which is a subject matter of this petition was in violation of the provisions of law and calls upon the noticees therein to restore the land to its original state or to bring it in conformity with the provisions of law. The noticees have not been impleaded in this writ petition. They are obviously necessary parties. It is not necessary, however, at this stage to entertain this writ petition.

2. The petitioners have addressed a communication dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-12) to the official respondents calling upon them to implement the order dated 16.03.2015. There is no response to the same as yet. The petitioners have not made any inquiries as to whether there is any challenge to the order dated 16.03.2015. Absent anything else, we are sure that the authorities will implement the order dated 16.03.2015 in accordance with law.

3. The petition is disposed of by directing the official respondents to respond to the petitioners' representation dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-12).
