AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would file objections to the notice dated 26.07.2013 (Annexure P-2) within a period of four weeks to the Superintending Engineer, Operation Circle Kaithal. He further states that a direction may be issued to the said officer to consider the same and take a decision within some specified time.

Counsel for the respondents also very fairly states that in case, the petitioner files the objections within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the concerned officer, as per the latest regulations, within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of the said objections. He further states that the objections will be considered and decided on merits and there will be no objection with regard to the delay in submission of the objections.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the parties, the

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present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file objections within a period of four weeks to the Superintending Engineer, Operation Circle Kaithal, who shall, on receipt of the same, decide them within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such objections.

In case the petitioner is entitled to some benefits, the same be released to the petitioner within a further period of six weeks. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
