Prayer in the present writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to permit the petitioner to attend classes in the Department of Sports Medicine and Physiotherapy of which, the petitioner is a 3rd semester student, on account of no prior notice for not depositing the 3rd semester fees.

Vide order dated 09.09.2015, the petitioner was directed to deposit the late fees of Rs.5000/-, subject to formal sanction of the Syndicate and she was allowed to attend classes. It is not disputed that the said amount has been paid.

Counsel for the respondent-University, however, points out that sufficient opportunities were given to the petitioner to deposit the fees along with 3 other students also, of different courses but of the same Department and that the petitioner was well aware that she had to deposit the fees.

Without going into the controversy regarding the fact whether the petitioner was issued notice or not and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been penalised by directing a deposit of a sum of Rs.5000/- as late fees, the petitioner is allowed to continue with her course. Accordingly, the interim order dated 09.09.2015 hereby stands confirmed.

With the abovesaid direction, the present writ petition stands allowed.
