Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing order dated 21.06.2013 (Annexure P/13), order dated 30.07.2013 (Annexure P/14), order dated 19.08.2013 (Annexure P/15) passed by respondent no.3 – Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Sirsa.

The claim of the petitioner is that he has performed certain works for respondents no. 2 and 3 for which entire payment has not been made by respondents no. 2 and 3 till date. The claim of the petitioner has been rejected vide letters dated 21.06.2013, 30.07.2013 and 19.08.2013 (Annexures P/13 to P/15 respectively).

will have to prove his case in accordance with law. Such facts cannot be appreciated in exercise of the writ jurisdiction. The petitioner will be at liberty to avail alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.
