The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the order dated 04.08.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No. 1, whereby the case has been remanded to the Director for decision afresh.

Brief facts of the case are that respondent No. 5 was suspended from the post of Sarpanch under Section 20(6) of

the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994. Against that, the petitioner preferred an appeal before the Financial Commissioner and the Financial Commissioner has remanded the case to decide it afresh.

Since the matter has been remanded to the Director, the petitioner can be given liberty to raise all the objections before the concerned authority.

It is stated that the matter is pending for 20.10.2015. It is directed that the parties shall appear before the competent authority on the date fixed. The competent authority shall hear the parties and dispose of the petition on the date fixed or within 15 days thereafter.
