Challenge in the present writ petition is to the final answer key prepared by the respondents for the purpose of short-listing the candidates for the written examination of Haryana Civil Services (Judicial Branch).

Apart from the deletion of five questions, the grievance of the petitioner is in respect of question No.90 in Code 'D' set.

The question in respect of legality of deletion of five questions has been examined by this Court in CWP No.2117 of 2015 titled 'Ankita Mittal Vs. State of Haryana and others' decided on 09.02.2015. However, in respect of question No.90 in Code 'D' Set, Mr. Vikas Behl, Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the High Court-respondent No.4, states that the Committee has decided to delete the said question not to give either credit or

discredit of such question. As a result of such decision, the answer sheets shall be re-evaluated and any candidate, who becomes eligible, shall be called for mains examination, but the candidates already called for mains examination shall not be disqualified.

In view of the above said fact, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to publish the revised result.
