(Annexure P/8) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Needful shall be done preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The petitioner will be at liberty qua the other relief to proceed in accordance with law and avail the remedy available to him.

Disposed of accordingly.
