Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the show cause notice dated 21.06.2014 (Annexure P/8) and writ of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to join as PGT Punjabi w.e.f. 14.12.2013.

The claim of the petitioner is that though he was selected and issued appointment letter, but under the garb of verification of experience certificate, he was not permitted to join. Show cause notice dated 21.06.2014 (Annexure P/8) was issued to the petitioner, the relevant extract of which is extracted below:-

“xx xx xx xx

<i>Name of School</i>	<i>Observations in regard to the experience</i>
<i>Guru Hari Krishan Sr. Sec. School, Vill. Raikhana Distt. Karnal</i>	<i>No name of Principal in Attendance Register, but stamp and sign is in every month. A-Roll is available but seems prepared afresh. Committee is of the opinion that the experience is not genuine.</i>

xx xx xx xx”

The petitioner has already filed reply to the aforesaid show cause notice on 05.07.2014 (Annexure P/9). However, till date no final decision has been taken, though other candidates, in whose cases certain objections were raised, have been permitted to join duty.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take a final decision on the show cause notice issued to the petitioner, to which he has already filed reply, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
