Environment & Health Protection Society, Punjab has filed the instant writ petition for quashing of resolution dated 03.03.2014 (Annexure P-19) passed by Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana- respondent No.3, whereby the proposal for making amendment in the 7th Building and Town Planning Scheme allowing the mix land use (Industrial), has been challenged.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 states that this writ petition is pre-mature as after the above said resolution, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana will invite objections from the general public on the

proposed amendment including the petitioner- association who would be at liberty to make objections to those amendments, and after hearing and considering all those objections, the matter will be referred to the State Government. But that stage has not reached as yet. This factual position has not been disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed being premature with liberty to the petitioner-association to file objections to the proposed amendment invited by the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana. In case, such objections are filed, the same will be considered and decided by the Municipal Corporation-respondent No.3, in accordance with law.
