MAHESH GROVER, J.

Petitioner contends that she is entitled to medical allowance, risk allowance, uniform allowance etc. which were given to her at one point of time but these benefits have now been stalled unilaterally without giving any opportunity of hearing to her.

No order to this effect has been placed on record, however, petitioner has already served a legal notice upon the respondents. Hence, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.2 to consider the grievance of the petitioner as contained in the legal notice and take a decision thereon by passing a speaking order and granting opportunity of hearing to her, positively within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
