Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the award dated 07.08.2012 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Faridkot in complaint No.44 dated 25.01.2012 whereby respondent No.1-Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Faridkot has made the proposal dated 16.05.2012 (Annexure P-5) as final.

During the pendency of petition, matter has been compromised between the parties. Respondent No.2 has filed affidavit to the effect that matter has been compromised; he has received the amount and nothing remains due towards the Post Office Department and he has no objection, if petition is disposed of accordingly. He also undertakes to withdraw the pending execution application filed by him. The affidavit, filed by respondent No.2 in Court today, is taken on record.

In view of compromise arrived at between the parties, impugned award dated 07.08.2012 (Annexure P-6) is set aside and complaint filed by respondent No.2 before respondent No.1 is dismissed. Respondent No.2 is directed to withdraw the execution application filed by him.
