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1. *Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?*

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**SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]**

The petitioner seeks a *Mandamus* to direct the respondents to appoint an independent observer and to videograph the entire election process of Gram Panchayat, Neemkhera, Tehsil Ferozepur Jhirka, District Mewat.

In deference to the order dated 11.09.2015, Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Ferozepur Jhirka has filed her reply/affidavit explaining that serial numbers of Polling Stations of village Neemkhera have now changed from 108 and 109 to 115 and 116. She has stated that both the Polling Stations in village Neemkhera have been declared “hyper-sensitive” and senior officers of the District Administration visited the spot on 10.09.2015 for making adequate security arrangements. She has further explained that police force shall be sufficiently deployed and video-recording of the entire polling proceedings shall be carried out in both the Booths.

We are satisfied with the arrangements made by the District Administration at both the Polling Stations of village Neemkhera located in the premises of its Government High School. We have no reasons to doubt that the District Administration shall take the call and ensure all necessary measures for the fair and free poll at these Polling Stations.

Disposed of. Dasti.
