1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

By this petition two reliefs are sought. The first relief is that the petitioner should have been appointed in the place of respondent No.3 because he has higher marks than him in the type test, net speed and written test. It is however not disputed that selection was made on the basis of five parameters and if the marks obtained in all the five parameters are added then the respondent No.3 has higher marks than the petitioner. In these circumstances, no fault can be found with the selection of the respondent No.3 vis-a-vis the petitioner.

The second prayer made is that the University has filled up

more posts than were advertised. Learned counsel has admitted that this relief is in the nature of public interest because even if this prayer is allowed the petitioner would not be successful in getting a job.

Consequently, the learned counsel prays for permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a PIL if so advised.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
