All the six petitioners claiming themselves to be 1984 riot victims and alleged to have been issued Red Cards by the State of Punjab, have filed this petition seeking direction to the respondents to allot flats to them as per the policy of allotment of houses/booths to the Sikh riot affected families, as applicable in the case of the petitioners.

It is the case of the petitioners that in this regard, they have submitted a representation dated 22.07.2014 to the Government, copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the said representation is still pending with the Government and the Government, after verifying the claims of the petitioners has not forwarded their aforesaid representation to the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) – respondent No.3 for considering their case for allotment of flats to them under the aforesaid policy.

In view of the above, we dispose of this petition with a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to verify the claim of the petitioners in accordance with the aforesaid policy within a period of two months and forward the aforesaid representation to GMADA – respondent No.3. The GMADA – respondent No.3 is further directed to consider the claim of the petitioners by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months.
