**MAHESH GROVER.J.**

The petitioner impugns the selection lists dated 8.12.2003 and 15.3.2004. In the considered view of this Court the instant writ petition is hopelessly barred by delay and laches. He further pleads that there are subsequent judgments which would govern the case of the petitioner. If that is so, then the petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedy with the respondents and seek appropriate relief regarding implementation of the orders of the writ court in case they are applicable to him. In so far as the present writ petition is concerned, the same being hit by delay and laches necessarily deserves to be dismissed. Ordered accordingly.
