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MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner impugns the order of suspension. His plea is that he has been victimized on the ground that he has pursued his cause for promotion. No allegations of mala fide have been levelled against any specific person.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the view that suspension is not a punishment and as per the settled law this court would not like to interfere unless it is shown that such an order is based on mala fides. Finding no such material on record, the instant petition is held to be without any merit and is dismissed leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law.
