**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)**

So long as the arrangement made in the order dated 11.8.2015 does not displace the petitioner from Amritsar and he would continue to serve at the station for the remaining 9 months in his first year of extension granted after superannuation then he can have no legitimate grievance merely because his salary will be drawn against the post of Chief Divisional Draftsman lying vacant in Electrical Division, Faridkot. It is not the case that he has not been paid salary which is available to him in Amritsar but drawn from the vacant post at Faridkot by a fiscal arrangement of the Government. In order to allay the fears of the petitioner that this remote control arrangement may not bring him any delay of payment of salary every month, a direction is issued to the Government to strictly honour its arrangement made in the order dated 11.8.2015, passed by the Chief Engineer(Headquarter) Punjab PWD B&R Branch, Patiala, it is directed that the said order will remain operational and the Chief Engineer(Headquarter) would ensure that the salary is disbursed to the petitioner at Amrtisar on the day it is released to all other

employees every month so that the petitioner does not have to approach anyone to access his salary and it is paid dot of time.

With these directions, this petition stands disposed of.
