Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents not to install the Ground Base Telecom Tower in a thickly populated area.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that tower is being installed in the green belt which is contrary to instructions (Annexure P/6), which have been adopted by the State of Haryana.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the

respondents, with a direction to respondents to look into the grievance of

the petitioner specifically made in representation dated 08.08.2015 (Annexure P/4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, after verifying the facts at the spot, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner. In case, tower is installed contrary to the instructions, then respondent no.4 – Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon shall take appropriate action for removal of the same.
